Notes:

- 1. Lifts to start 08:00 am. Members are asked to have their boats ready for lifting, be on time to attend the safety talk prior to commencing scheduled lift operations, as well as remain on site for the full day to assist with all lift operations and cradle movements scheduled for that day.
- 2. Schedule is based on 10 lifts / day. Lifts not complete will move to the next lift day on schedule. If more than 10 lifts / day completed, crew can proceed with lifts to be done on the next lift day. Lift Operators are asked to advise progress each day to Wharf Chair to allow schedule update.
- 3. Should weather impact the lifting operations, schedule will commence the next suitable day. TNYC will advise schedule updates as required.
- 4. Members that can't be lifted out on the day scheduled, require to be lifted in before or after the scheduled lift in date, do not see their boat listed, or require additional information are asked to contact the Wharf Chair Trevor Giles at trevoregiles@hotmail.com, or cell 749-9114. TNYC will make best effort to accommodate where possible and having no impact to the lift in schedule. Any adjustment to schedule that would result in the need for additional move(s) of a member's boat to progress other lift in's per schedule may be subject to additional HMPC lift fees.
- 5. TNYC members are reminded of HMPC policy that no boat will be lifted in until they have signed the HMPC agreement and waiver form.

6.	Members supporting lift operations are encouraged to come prepared with and wear appropriate personnel protective equipment (PPE) such as gloves, steel toe boots and hard hat.
